

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-08

AN ORDINANCE STATING NO OBJECTION TO PRIVATE CLUB LICENSE FOR CANTINA CINCO DE MAYO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Malvern City Council desires to adopt this ordinance declaring no objection to the application for a private club license by Cantina Cinco de Mayo pursuant to Act 1112 of 2017.

WHEREAS, the City of Malvern passed Resolution No. 05-2022 stating it had no objection to the application by Cantina Cinco de Mayo. The Arkansas Beverage Control regulations require an Ordinance rather than a Resolution for application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Malvern City Council that the City of Malvern restates it has no objection to the application for a private club license by Cantina Cinco de Mayo pursuant to Act 1112 of 2017.

WHEREAS, passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Malvern, and this ordinance is effective upon its passage by the Council. An emergency exists due to the timeliness of the application.

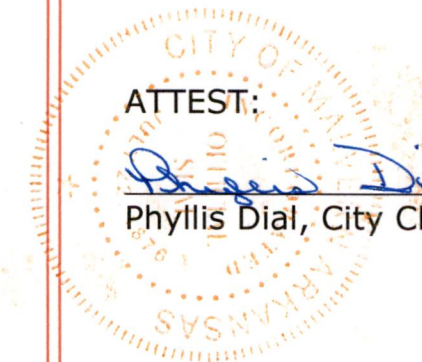
